The waves of Punta Roca (or "La Punta", as it is called by the local surfers) break to the right on a rocky bed and is considered to be one of the 10 best places in the world for surfing according to the pros. In fact, professional surfers who have ridden these waves have compared them to the famous Jeffrey Bay waves in South Africa with the added appeal of its warm water: no wetsuits necessary!

Due to its power and speed, these waves are suitable for advanced and experienced surfers.

When you arrive at Punta Roca, local children and young people will offer to take care of your car and your belongings; you will also see local photographers who will gladly freeze time for you with a picture, inmortalizing the moment of a lifetime.







Visited by hundreds of local and foreign tourists weekly, this beach wasn't always a big attraction. Back in the seventies and eighties, it was a small remote little town, next to a quiet estuary. Nowadays, it has become a must-visit destination for international surfers and for those who seek to immerse themselves in the bohemian surf culture.

It has a powerful point break, withstanding waves up to 10 feet high (3.5 meter), with thick and heavy long strides and -sometimes- with wave tunnels. This wave is recommended and suitable for advanced and expirienced surfers. It has a virtue of breaking throughout most of the year.







El Sunzal has a breaker zone that supports the largest waves in the entire salvadoran coast, without closing. There have been occasions of extraordinary tidal waves, up to 25 feet high (8.5 meters)... and yes, they have been ridden, between March and October, waves between 8 and 15 feet height (2.5 to 5 meters) are specially common, and are caused by storms in the southern Pacific Ocean. Among these swells, El Sunzal usually offers a gentle side, a favorite wave for befinners.

Due to its similarity to some waves in California (such as Rincon), El Sunzal and Punta Roca were, in 1977, part of the locations of the iconic surf film Big Wednesday, starring Jam-Michael Vincent, Gary Busey, and William Katt; and whose stuntmen in the surf scenes were the famous surfers Gerry Lopez, Peter Townend, and Ian Caims, who never stopped praising the quality of these waves.







El Zonte has several sections for surfing. The most popular is La Punta, a rock formation, with a break to the right, which creates a fast long lined wave, occasionally tubular; it can reach up to 10 feet (3.5 meters), and protrudes to a small beach that has a cliff at it's eastern end, which should be avoided on days with large swells.

From the tip to the west there are 2 other sectios, the first is a left wave that forms on the rocky bed at the mouth of the river; it's a fast, long and powerful wave.

Then, it's followed by a "beach break" area, characterized by it's speed and inclination, a short line, and tubular segments, crashing against the sandy beach.





PUNTA MANGO

Punta Mango is a mythical beach, located in San Miguel. Known only by a lucky few until recently, it's now on the bucket list of any surfer at heart.

The waves at Punta Mango are among the most demanding of the entire Salvadoran coast. Reserved for experts only, on it's best days, this rocky breakout point to the right creates a powerful, fast, tubular, long-lined wave that winds its way down to its death in a sandy inlet.







Playa Las Flores is located in San Miguel. The small and beautiful cove that greets the traveler marks the beginning of a series of rocky points, with waves breaking to the right, perfect for surfing, which extend one after another for several kilometers, from the east of the Salvadoran coast to the west.

In december and january, this beach offers gentle waves, suitable for beginners and intermediates; but when the swells of the South Pacific Ocean arrive, especially between March and October, prepare yourself for waves of up to 12 feet high (4 meters), with long and steep lines that move quickly over a semi-rocky bottom, until they merge with the volcanic gray sand of its shore.

Scientific studies have shown that this is an area rich in nutrients, which attract these huge mammals. Here they feed and rest in the waters during January and February, before continuing the migration endeavor been Alaska its destination. Tours are always available by the locals to enjoy this unique show. This tourist destination has had a huge boom, resulting in many new accommodations, restaurants and other services.
